- 1. 2019 SJ Budget Feedback.** Every year, the Neighborhoods Commission submits its annual Budget Letter, comprised of your feedback on how to spend San Jose funds in the areas of Code Enforcement, Public Safety, and Transportation to the Mayor and City Council. Please provide your feedback on where you think San Jose should allocate funds in these categories. Last year's budget feedback response from D1LG was very good. The D1LG has distributed the flyer requesting the feedback including how to respond. Please respond by January 6, 2020.
- 2. 2020 Neighborhoods Commission Workplan.** The NC has developed its 2020 workplan. Among the items proposed are policies and strategies for deterring illegal fireworks, fostering community engagement, providing the NC budget recommendations for the SJ 2020 budget, disaster preparedness, illegal dumping, access to transportation, and SJ Police Department manning.
- 1. Independent Citizens Oversight Committee (ICOC) FY 2018-2019.** The committee is in support of Measure B, which enacted a ¼ percent sales tax for 15 years and requires Independent Citizens Oversight with public review of spending, and all revenues controlled locally. The committee is in the process of planning the review of spending for the period from 10/1/2018 to 6/30/2019.
