- Measure T do we have resources to support the infrastructure bond? Yes
 - Plans for Westgate West? TBD
 - Focus on Building Better Neighborhoods
 - Grassroots Proposal (Steve)
 - First, need to attract new leaders.
 - Start by focusing on smaller geographic areas; maybe a few blocks or streets.
 - Enable these leaders to get things done (contacts for city services for example)
 - Integrate them into the existing neighborhood associations through board meetings, etc.
 - Maybe have an annual training meeting sponsored by D1.
 - WONA indicated that they have gotten about 60% of their streets involved to some extent; passing out flyers. Most effective was participation through neighborhood watch meetings;
 - Stevens Creek – 2/3 of their 5k are rentals. Difficult to get people who are renting vested in the neighborhood. Street leaders didn't prove fruitful for Stevens Creek Neighborhood Association.
 - WeChat and Line are often used by Chinese-American residents.
 - Office of Cultural Affairs **Action: ask for presentation at future D1 meeting.**
 - Parent Groups are another resources.
 - Bob asked how we reach out to the Indian community as well.
 - Steve suggested that we start with Emergency Preparation (CERT) as a focus point and provided an outline of how it could be done.
 - Doris reported that Murdock is hosting a Neighborhood Watch meeting on Thursday 11/15/18 at 7PM at Lynnbrook High School. This approach could be adapted to other focus areas.
 - Additional ideas – food share, common agricultural
 - **Action: Learn from Elizabeth on getting neighbors involved**
 - Gary says Strawberry Square working on emergency prep
 - D1LG Survey Update and Discussion
 - 12 responses so far
 - 82% have been involved more than 4 years
 - Most votes for updates from Councilman Jones and city services presentations
 - **Action: Steve to include next meeting dates in the D1LG invite**
 - **Action: Steve to reach out to each NA asking for representation in D1LG**
 - **Action: Ken to put minutes on D1LG website**
 - Neighborhood Announcements
