What are Multimodal Transportation Improvement Plans (MTIPS)?


Objectives:

To <u>identify and prioritize</u> <u>projects</u> that align with local and citywide goals

Produce <u>designs</u>, estimates, and implementation strategies for highest priority improvements


Focus City efforts to **implement** highest priority items




What are Multimodal Transportation Improvement Plans (MTIPS)?

Transportation Network that Aligns with the General Plan and Climate Smart San Jose

Mode	2019	2030 Goal	2040 Goal


