- Vice Mayor Jones Wishing everyone a great holiday
- Discuss crime
 - Tried to get SJPD to join this meeting, but not able
 - Recent next-door postings indicate crime is increasing
 - Expect to see peaks and valleys, so hard to see trends
 - Changes in Federal and State laws are impacting
 - We are trying to address at the local level
 - Need everyone to lobby representatives change laws
 - Willing to have follow-up meetings to help address this
- Development
 - Costco plans are getting attention
 - Dec 16 5:30 Zoom meeting
 - El Paso
 - EIR circulating, meeting in late Jan
- SB9
 - Next council meeting staff will suggest we stop work on Opportunity Housing now that SB9 is in place
- Redistriciting
 - Don't expect a large impact on D1 except Santa Row
 - A few streets east of HW 17
- Charter review
 - Commission is done, will submit to council Jan 11
- Other updates
 - Vice Mayor Jones is now Chair of VTA and president of Cities Association
- Annale's update
 - Vehicle abatement meeting with DOT
 - Funding didn't work out, working on other options
 - Doing some proactive vehicle tagging now
 - 311 responses continue to be slow
- Raania's update
 - Working with neighboring cities,
 - Steering committee meeting on Steven's Creek Corridor
 - Upcoming bikeway improvements

- Road pavings progressing

 - A: (Vice Mayor Jones) Maybe if there are funds left over we may be able to allocate.
 - A: (Raania) \$103 k is remaining; once we can ensure all D1 Decides projects are funded, we can then determine use of remaining funds according to city policy.
 - Q: (Steve L) Any specific laws impacting crime rate?
 - A: (VMJ) Zero bail, early release. Voted for Prop 47, seemed like a good thing, releasing people, but not providing the rehab
 - Q: (Amy) Update on RHNA reporting? Are we looking at what El Paseo doing compared to neighboring cities?
 - A: (VJM) Will follow up
 - Q: (Justin L) Can you able to share information on how to join the upcoming meeting about Stevens Creek Blvd with VTA/ Santa Clara/Cupertino?
